JSC (Grade 10) with 23 points in 6 subjects, E symbol in English and Mathematics.

ADDITIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

PRE-VOCATIONAL SUBJECTS

New Curriculum (NSSCO) (Grade 11) 18 points in 6 subjects, F symbol in English, Mathematics and Physics / Chemistry. D symbol in the respective pre-vocational subject.

PROGRESSION

National Vocational Certificate/statement of results (from NTA registered and NQA accredited institution / training provider).

FOREIGN QUALIFICATIONS

Foreign qualification/s must be accompanied by Namibia Qualification Authority (NQA) evaluation report.
